

Help — Clutch Assembly The springs on the clutch shoes are very strong and difficult to assemble see photograph for the way in which we used a guide pin alternatively you can buy an Ansmann clutch installation too.

We used a rod to keep the spring lined on up with the holes in the clutch shoe and then slid it onto the flywheel pin using a small screw driver and pliers
