Teamwork and Presentation

Task:

To design a Presentation and display for your Formula Schools entry.

Introduction

Teamwork is an important area to consider when setting up your team. Having clear tasks and an identity is important. Also demonstrating you have the ability to organise and present your work in a structured way is vital to demonstrate what you have learned through this aspect of the challenge.

Research Section

What different forms of presentation do you have available to you? What different areas can we break the team down into? What areas of the project are there in the marking scheme? What evidence will we need to show later?

Design section

Collect information over time, on the team and their specific jobs using a digital or still camera. Take images showing students at work on their aspect of the project.

Use a computer to build a presentation showing how your team is broken down. Include maybe a time line that you have planned for the build.

Write a short list of the responsibilities of each member of the team and what their skills are.

Produce a chart showing how the responsibility is broken down

Work out how team responsibilities will change on race day and who will be responsible for which tasks. Break this down and include in your presentation.
